Branch Manager's Report

- b. Grant for \$500 was received from Velasco FreeMasons Lodge.
- c. The book for the Gulf Coast Reads is "The Dog Stars."

- e. The City of Freeport will be providing trolley rides from the library to the planetarium show on October 19th.
- f. Freeport library will participate in Trunk or Treats, October 25th.

Library Director's Report

- a. Author dinner on August 29th with J.D. Davies and Mickey Gilley was a big success. Mr. Gilley donated his time to the event.
- b. A \$7,500 grant was received for AWE computer replacement. The computers are geared towards elementary age kids (no pre-k). County is purchasing for Angleton, Lake Jackson, Brazoria and Pearland.
- c. The Library System is entering into a partnership with Bay Area Council on Drug & Alcohol Abuse for a "Prescription Drug Take Back Day" on October 26th. Any prescription drug, expired or not, will be accepted. This also includes illicit drugs.

- d. The Rose Mobile Mammography unit will be at those libraries that have separate meeting rooms. Doctors' orders are needed in order to obtain a mammogram. The Mobile unit will claim on insurance or, if lacking insurance, will take you for free.
- e. November is Alzheimer Awareness Month. Brazoria County Library System, in conjunction with The Gathering Place, will conduct testing. The Gathering Place will provide screeners.
- f. All library employees will receive a 2% COLA raise this fiscal year, while those in Steps 1 thru 6 will receive a 3% increase.
- g. Brazoria County Commissioners are conducting a candidate search for a new library director to replace Catherine Threadgill. Applications are being considered from outside the area as well as current qualified library employees.
- h. The Library System is adding a new on-line streaming video service Hoopla available for home use.
- i. Searching for a new EBook vendor. "Overdrive" currently has a monopoly.
- j. Freeport Library received a \$2,000 Target grant to be used for a telescope and associated program.

- a. Margie Edwards is stepping down from The County Library Board. Commissioner Payne, who is the representative for Freeport, is searching for a replacement.
- b. Nancy Hackney, the Lake Jackson librarian is retiring the end of October. A library cataloger retired this past Friday. Replacements are sought.
